Would customers please note that if you are sending this type of item for cancellation, to please send these to the Northern SHC only were we will be able to apply The Alternative First Day of Issue Postmark. Due to the size of this type of item a 180-degree foil is required to ensure that no damage is caused to the sheets.

## NON-BARCODE MACHIN DEFINITIVE AND COUNTRY STAMPS

Please note that after 31 January 2023 all non-barcode Machin Definitive (Queen's Head) stamps, and all non-barcode Country Definitive Stamps, will be invalidated. This also means that these stamps will no longer be valid for cancellation by our Special Handstamp Centres.

Customers can either use up these stamps before this deadline or swap them for the new barcoded stamps via our Stamp Swap-Out Scheme – full details of the scheme can be found at:

- All customers are reminded there is **currently no end date for the Stamp Swap-Out Scheme**.
- All decimal (from 1971) Special Stamps (also known as pictorial and commemorative stamps) will remain valid for postage and for cancellation through our Special Handstamp Centres.

Postmark users may be aware of recent media coverage concerning an extension for the use of non-barcode stamps beyond 31 January 2023. To clarify, 31 January 2023 remains the date when non-barcode Machin and Country Definitive stamps become invalid as previously advised. However, mail posted with these stamps after 31 January 2023, will be delivered and no surcharges will be raised. After this 6 month grace period surcharges will apply as normal for mail with insufficient postage.

**Important note regarding the affixing of Barcoded stamps to your items sent to Special Handstamp Centres and on general mail.**

- A barcode stamp is the full stamp, fully contained on all sides by the perforations.
- To half the stamps in any way, either by removing the barcode or not showing the barcode, is exactly the same as removing part of any Special or Definitive Stamp.
- This would render the stamp invalid for postage, and we would not cancel part of a stamp.

## SPECIAL HANDSTAMPS — NOTICES

### Clarification on Sponsored Postmarks

We have recently become aware of instances where Sponsors have included their own brands in their designs when sponsoring a Postmark. This runs counter to how we had always intended Sponsored Postmarks to operate as the intention has always been to ensure that all Postmarks are open to anyone to use.

We accept that it is unfortunate that we did not spot this sooner and we apologise for any confusion this may have caused.

Now we are aware of it, we want to clarify that it is important to us to promote choice and for Postmarks to be of general use and support for the hobby. To be clear we would consider branding for events, especially philatelic or collectable events, so long as these are of general use and interest. We would also consider branding that relates to recognised Philatelic or Collectibles Organisations, which again would be of interest and appeal to collectors generally. By contrast company names would restrict use by Postmark users will not be accepted.

In order to address this issue for the long term we will update the terms and conditions of our Sponsored Postmark Contract to clarify the use of brands on all Sponsored Postmarks.

**Please Note:** That the following postmarks are all back in operation however due to the change in the equipment these are not suitable for use on Postcards when the stamps are affixed to the pictorial side of the card which results in the ink smudging due to the glossy nature of the cards.

## COLOURED INKS

Sponsors of special handstamps may, for an additional fee, have the handstamps on their own covers applied in coloured inks. Unless otherwise stated in this Bulletin, covers sent in under the reposting service will have the postmarks applied in black ink. Indication of the use of any coloured inks will be given and readers interested in acquiring covers bearing these coloured postmarks should contact the sponsor for further information.

## FORTHCOMING SPECIAL HANDSTAMPS — UPDATED

Items for reposting, individually addressed and bearing at least the **2<sup>nd</sup> class** postage rate for UK addressed items should be sent to the reposting address given. To ensure prompt handling please mark the outer cover 'Special Handstamp' and state clearly the serial number(s) of the handstamp(s) required. On the first day of issue of new stamps items not clearly marked will receive the 'First Day of Issue' cancellation. The outer cover must bear normal postage and only those items bearing the postmark on or before the date of the special handstamp will be eligible for the cancellation. Collectors who want their covers/cards returned under cover after handstamping should enclose a suitable self-addressed envelope. This need not bear additional postage stamps, the postage being already paid by the stamp affixed to the covers for postmarking. The handstamp illustrations in this bulletin are approximately full size; we regret we cannot guarantee that the actual postmark impressions will be the same size as the illustrations. The handstamps are announced in sections for each of the Special Handstamp Centres, and where relevant Royal Mail Talents House, Forces Post Office, and other handstamping places. They are shown in date order with the name and address of the sponsor given at the end of each section.

For customers submitting covers/cards for more than one postmark, please use/provide a separate envelope for each postmark. Customers are also asked to clearly mark/identify the postmark number required. This will help us process the covers/cards more efficiently.

### PERMANENT CLOSURE OF BFPS

It is 10 years since BFPS was formed to take over and operate the then dormant Forces Philatelic Bureau to reinstate the production of commemorative covers and special handstamps to mark military events and anniversaries. After careful consideration the two volunteer directors of BFPS, Graham Meacher and Darrell Drury, have decided it is time to retire and have made the decision to dissolve BFPS CIC at the end of the current financial year.

During its decade of operation, BFPS has collaborated with many organisations, both civilian and military, to produce philatelic covers to commemorate over 100 anniversaries and special events. In addition, we have produced First Day Covers, Smilers® and specials. We have also issued a large number of bespoke 'British Forces Postal Service' special handstamps, each uniquely numbered and very popular with philatelists.

Apart from resurrecting the Forces Philatelic Bureau, the other main aim of BFPS has been to fundraise for Service charities and in this we have been successful with tens of thousands of pounds having been donated to both the charities related to the covers produced or other worthy charities such as SSAFA, the Armed Forces charity.

We are very proud of what we have achieved and we would like to thank our friends and family, who have supported us and helped make BFPS a success. We would also like to thank our customers and regular subscribers for the tremendous support shown by purchasing our covers.

We plan to hold a closing down sale and the online shop will cease trading by the end of the year. Any stock remaining on hand will be donated to good causes.

## SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT

### Important Guidance for Sponsoring Postmarks

The current postmark policy booklet was last reviewed and published in 2007. Much has changed since then not least of which Postmark Bulletin moving to a monthly publication as well as publishing them online. The review will consider a number of options and developments and as regular customers and users your input into the review would be welcome, you can do so via [os&ths\\_enquiries@royalmail.com](mailto:os&ths_enquiries@royalmail.com) marking your email Policy Review Feedback.

In the meantime, one area of confusion concerns the application timescales for Sponsored Postmarks so we can offer the following updated guidance below.

- Postmarks must be published in the Postmark Bulletin before the date of the postmark.
- The normal publication date for the Bulletin is the last Friday of each month.
- To ensure contracts can be finalised, materials ordered, and the Bulletin published, all sponsorship applications must be submitted by the 1<sup>st</sup> of the preceding month. The table below details all the cut-off dates.

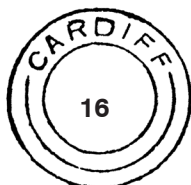
